Program 'Colonial Fifing'

Compatriot Ray Cox, Texas SAR Society Webmaster gave a great program of the use of the fife during the Revolutionary War for Command and Control of all activities in the daily life of a soldier. There were Fife Calls for every activity of the day and Ray played over 14 individual examples. Fifers were young boys or older men and were picked by officers to perform these important duties. The sound of the fife and drum could be heard even when the cannon roared and hundreds of rifles were fired. The Swiss are

credited with first using the fife for military 'communications' in the 16<sup>th</sup> C and it was soon adopted by all the major European powers. Ray emphasized that fife and drum calls were based on the common and popular songs of the day. Who knew that there are 200 verses to Yankee Doodle Dandy and that the American Patriots took a song written in derision and turned it into a badge of honor...stuck a feather in his hat and called it .... 'Up with Rebels, Down with the British'.
