**This Day in History** – by Don Stone; on 18 October 1867, William Seward, U.S. Secretary of State, finalized the purchase of the Territory of Alaska from the Czar of Russia for \$7.2 million dollars. This purchase was pilloried in the U.S. Press and was commonly referred to as 'Seward's Folly'. Thirty years later GOLD was discovered in Alaska. Seems like the purchase was not so much a folly after all.
