They will be collaborating with the Montgomery County Veterans Commission to have it placed at the Veterans Park in Conroe. This will be revisited at the September Chapter meeting.
- Ed Sellards announced that Compatriot Charles Lano has earned the SAR 250th Silver Medal.
- President Byram shared a picture from the Conroe Courier of our Chapter Compatriots with Coushatti Trace DAR ladies at the 30th of June 'Reading of the Declaration of Independence' on the steps of the Conroe Court House.

This Day in History – by Don Stone; General 'Andy' Jackson was appointed to command all troops in the New Orleans area this day, 15 August 1814. The Chapter was entertained with Johnny Horton's highly popular 1959 hit "<u>the Battle of New</u> <u>Orleans</u>"'we fired our guns and the British kept-a-coming....there wasn't nigh as many as there was a while ago.....we fired once more and they begin a runnin' on down the Mississippi to the Gulf of Mexico.'
